- 18 <u>directive</u>, or standard".
- 19 (4) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in added Section 36.004(c),
- 20 Insurance Code, strike "an interim" and substitute "a".
- 21 (5) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the
- 22 bill and renumber SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- 23 SECTION _____. Section 36.004, Insurance Code, as amended by
- 24 this Act, applies only to a rule adopted or amended on or after the
