CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 1500 has been adopted by the house of
- 2 representatives and the senate and is being prepared for
- 3 enrollment; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
- 5 corrected; now, therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED by the 85th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
- 7 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed
- 8 to correct the enrolled version of House Bill No. 1500 by striking
- 9 Section 39.054(a-1), Education Code, as amended in both places by
- 10 the bill (Senate Floor Amendment No. 3, pages 2 and 3) and
- 11 substituting the following in the first place that subsection is
- 12 amended by the bill:
- 13 (a-1) In [For purposes of] assigning [an overall]
- 14 performance ratings [rating] under Subsection (a), the
- 15 commissioner may adjust the overall performance rating of a
- 16 district or campus if the performance of the district or campus
- 17 under the indicators described by Section 39.053(c), based on
- 18 information disaggregated by race, ethnicity, socioeconomic
- 19 status, or other factors, does not meet standards established by
- 20 <u>the commissioner. The commissioner</u> shall [attribute]:
- 21 (1) <u>attribute</u> 55 percent of the performance evaluation
- 22 to the achievement indicators for the first, second, and third
- 23 domains under Sections 39.053(c)(1)-(3), provided that the
- 24 commissioner shall consider either the district's or campus's

- 1 performance rating under the first domain or the second domain,
- 2 whichever performance rating is higher, unless the district or
- 3 campus received a performance rating of F in either domain, in which
- 4 case the district or campus may not be assigned an overall
- 5 performance rating higher than B;
- 6 (2) for middle and junior high school and elementary
- 7 campuses and districts that include only those campuses, attribute
- 8 35 percent of the performance evaluation to the applicable
- achievement indicators for the fourth domain under Section
- 10 39.053(c)(4);
- 11 (3) for high school campuses and districts that
- 12 include those campuses, attribute:
- 13 (A) 10 percent of the performance evaluation to
- 14 the high school graduation rate achievement indicator described by
- 15 Section 39.053(c)(4)(A)(ii); and
- 16 (B) 25 percent to the remaining applicable
- 17 achievement indicators for the fourth domain under Section
- 18 39.053(c)(4); and
- 19 (4) <u>attribute 10 percent of the performance evaluation</u>
- 20 to the locally selected and evaluated achievement indicators
- 21 provided for under the fifth domain under Section 39.053(c)(5).
