A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing that members of the
- 2 legislature and the lieutenant governor will not receive a state
- 3 salary or per diem during certain periods unless the legislature
- 4 has passed the state's budget and that budget is certified by the
- 5 comptroller.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 24, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 8 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 9 (d) This subsection applies only if the Comptroller of
- 10 Public Accounts has not certified, as provided by Section 49a(b) of
- 11 this article, before the 31st day after the last day of a Regular
- 12 <u>Session of the Legislature</u>, a general appropriations act that
- 13 constitutes this State's budget for the succeeding State fiscal
- 14 biennium. Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (c) of this section
- 15 and Section 17(b), Article IV, of this constitution, a Member of the
- 16 Legislature and the Lieutenant Governor while acting as President
- of the Senate are not entitled to receive any salary or per diem to
- 18 which those Officers would otherwise be entitled for the period
- 19 beginning on the 31st day after the last day of a Regular Session of
- 20 the Legislature and ending at the end of the day preceding the day
- 21 the Comptroller certifies a general appropriations act that
- 22 constitutes this State's budget for that succeeding State fiscal
- 23 biennium.
- 24 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to

- 1 the Texas Constitution:
- 2 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 3 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 85th Legislature,
- 4 Regular Session, 2017, to provide that members of the legislature
- 5 and the lieutenant governor will not receive a state salary or per
- 6 diem during certain periods unless the legislature has passed the
- 7 state's budget and that budget is certified by the comptroller.
- 8 (b) Section 24(d), Article III, of this constitution
- 9 applies only in relation to the certification of a general
- 10 appropriations act that constitutes this state's budget for a state
- 11 fiscal biennium beginning on or after September 1, 2019.
- 12 (c) This temporary provision expires September 1, 2020.
- 13 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing that members
- 17 of the legislature and the lieutenant governor will not receive a
- 18 state salary or per diem during certain periods unless the
- 19 legislature has passed the state's budget and that budget is
- 20 certified by the comptroller."
