1-19 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-20 proposing a constitutional amendment limiting the service of
 1-21 certain officeholders after the expiration of the person's term of
 1-22 office.

1-23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 17, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 17. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
 1-27 section, all [~~All~~] officers of [~~within~~] this State shall continue
 1-28 to perform the duties of their offices until their successors shall
 1-29 be duly qualified.

1-30 (b) Following the expiration of a term of an appointive
 1-31 office that is filled by appointment of the Governor with the advice
 1-32 and consent of the Senate and that is not an office for which the
 1-33 officer receives a salary, the period for which the officer shall
 1-34 continue to perform the duties of office under Subsection (a) of
 1-35 this section ends on the last day of the first regular session of
 1-36 the Legislature that begins after the expiration of the term.

1-37 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
 1-38 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
 1-39 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
 1-40 proposition: "The constitutional amendment limiting the service of
 1-41 certain officeholders appointed by the governor and confirmed by
 1-42 the senate after the expiration of the person's term of office."
