A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the recognition
- 2 of equal rights of all people.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 3, Article I, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 3. All [free] men and women, when they form a social
- 7 compact, have equal rights, and no man or woman, or set of men or
- 8 women, is entitled to exclusive separate public emoluments, or
- 9 privileges, but in consideration of public services.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 3a, Article I, Texas Constitution, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 3a. Equality under the law shall not be denied or
- 13 abridged because of sex, race, color, creed, military status,
- 14 health status, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity or
- 15 expression, age, religion, disability, genetic information,
- 16 family, marital status, previous incarceration, or national
- 17 origin. This amendment is self-operative.
- 18 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 22 recognition of equal rights of all people."
