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	JOINT RESOLUTION

- 2 proposing a constitutional amendment to set aside general revenue
- 3 as dedicated to pay for certain state infrastructure projects.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 50-h to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 50-h. (a) The state infrastructure endowment fund is
- 8 <u>a fund created outside the state treasury.</u>
- 9 (b) Not later than the 90th day of each state fiscal year,
- 10 the comptroller of public accounts shall transfer from the general
- 11 revenue fund to the credit of the state infrastructure endowment
- 12 fund an amount equal to one-quarter of one percent of all general
- 13 <u>revenue that:</u>
- (1) came into the state treasury during the preceding
- 15 state fiscal year; and
- 16 (2) is not otherwise dedicated by or appropriated by
- 17 this constitution.
- 18 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b) of this section, the
- 19 <u>legislature by general law may provide for a percentage different</u>
- 20 from the percentage provided by that subsection. The percentage
- 21 may not be less than one-quarter of one percent or more than one
- 22 percent of the general revenue described by Subsection (b) of this
- 23 section.
- 24 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (f) of this section,

- 1 money transferred to the credit of the state infrastructure
- 2 endowment fund under this section and interest or other earnings on
- 3 that money shall be administered, without further appropriation, by
- 4 the Texas Treasury Safekeeping Trust Company or that company's
- 5 successor in function and shall be used only to:
- 6 (1) make payments of principal or interest on state
- 7 bonds the proceeds of which were used to pay for projects to repair,
- 8 renovate, rehabilitate, or construct state infrastructure other
- 9 than transportation infrastructure and higher education
- 10 facilities; or
- 11 (2) make payments under a credit agreement related to
- 12 bonds described by Subdivision (1) of this subsection.
- 13 (e) For purposes of Subsection (d) of this section:
- 14 (1) "Transportation infrastructure" means roads,
- 15 streets, ways, bridges, or culverts.
- 16 (2) "Higher education facilities" means property,
- 17 <u>buildings</u>, structures, or other facilities used or intended to be
- 18 used by a public institution of higher education.
- (f) The Texas Treasury Safekeeping Trust Company or that
- 20 company's successor in function shall retain in the state
- 21 infrastructure endowment fund a minimum balance of 95 percent of
- 22 the corpus of the fund.
- 23 (g) This subsection and Subsections (b) and (c) of this
- 24 section expire August 31, 2027.
- 25 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 26 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 27 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the

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- 1 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to set aside general
- 2 revenue as dedicated to pay for certain state infrastructure
- 3 projects."
