WHEREAS, In 2004, Mr. Jones brought his wealth of knowledge to the Texas Legislature as a legislative aide for Senator Royce West; during his two years of service, he provided invaluable advice in such areas as economic development and business and commerce, and he created the review procedure for Housing Tax Credit applications; and

WHEREAS, Roger Jones was a loving father who was widely respected for his service on behalf of communities in Texas and throughout the nation; he was beloved by many, and he leaves behind memories that will long be cherished by all who were privileged to share in his life; now, therefore, be it
