WHEREAS, The members of Church on the Rock in Daingerfield celebrated the 25th anniversary of their church's founding on September 25, 2016; and

WHEREAS, In 1991, the church was organized by about a dozen members; they soon appointed co-pastors, Dr. Ed Brockway, who later became associate pastor, and Randy Seybert, who has led the house of worship as senior pastor since the early 1990s; Pastor Seybert is supported in all his endeavors by his wife, Elizabeth Seybert, whose many responsibilities include administration, teaching, counseling, and oversight of the ladies' ministry; and

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 85th Legislature, hereby commemorate the 25th anniversary of the Church on the Rock and extend to the congregation sincere best wishes for many more years of shared prayer and fellowship; and, be it further
