WHEREAS, Among those who have contributed significantly to the Texas Chapter are Yolanda Adams, an award-winning gospel artist and the chapter governor from Houston; Kevin Russell, an Austin Music Hall of Fame Inductee and chapter governor from Austin; Paul Wall, a Grammy-nominated rap artist and chapter trustee from Houston; Ricky Anderson, an entertainment attorney and chapter governor from the Houston area; Sarah Jaffe, a musician and songwriter and chapter voting member from Denton; and Theresa Jenkins, the senior executive director of Grammys in Texas; and

WHEREAS, Music has been a vital part of the fabric of life in Texas since the state's founding, and it is truly fitting that a day be set aside to honor the state's musicians and their many achievements; now, therefore, be it
