WHEREAS, Public awareness is one of the most important tools in the fight to end child abuse and neglect; in observing National Child Abuse Prevention Month, citizens of the Lone Star State are taking a vital step toward ensuring that future generations of Texans receive every opportunity to realize their fullest potential; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 85th Legislature, hereby recognize April 2017 as Child Abuse

Prevention Month and call on all citizens to work together to protect the welfare of children throughout the state and beyond.
