WHEREAS, The students from Falfurrias High School were among more than 3,000 contestants facing off at the national level; their exhibit went on to place in the top 20 out of a field of 146, and it was also honored with the Outstanding Entry from Texas Award; this significant achievement was the culmination of over 175 hours of research, during which the students documented more than 100 sources and conducted 30 personal interviews in an effort to fully portray the life of Irma Rangel; along the way, they received support and encouragement from a number of individuals, including family members, former chiefs of staff and colleagues, and others who knew Ms. Rangel and benefited from her committed work as a public servant; and

WHEREAS, Through the time, effort, and thought that they invested in constructing their superb exhibit, these notable young Texans have brought great credit to themselves while focusing well-deserved attention on a distinguished figure in Texas history, and they may reflect with pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
