**IN RE: HB92** by Guillen (Relating to the entitlement of spouses of certain veterans with disabilities to a veteran's employment preference.), **As Introduced** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill amends the Government Code to expand the veteran employment preference qualification to include spouses of disabled veterans with total disability. It is assumed that any additional costs associated with the implementation of the bill would not be significant and could be absorbed within existing state resources.
