IN RE: HB233 by Rodriguez, Eddie (Relating to the exception of certain information related to the humane disposition by a municipality or county of an animal from required disclosure under the public information law.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code making information about a person confidential who obtains ownership or control of an animal to humanely dispose of the animal.

The bill would take effect immediately if the bill receives a two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise the bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

Local Government Impact

According to the Texas Municipal League, no significant fiscal impact is anticipated.
