IN RE: HB294 by Walle (Relating to the revocation of certain water utilities' certificate of public convenience and necessity for major rules violations.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Water Code relating to the revocation of certain water utilities' certificate of public convenience and necessity for major rules violations.
