**IN RE: HB449** by Guillen (Relating to the applicability of competitive bidding requirements to leases of radio towers and the land under radio towers procured by the Parks and Wildlife Department.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Parks and Wildlife Code to exempt the Parks and Wildlife Department from statutory competitive bidding requirements for procuring a lease for a radio tower or land under a radio tower.
