**IN RE: HB450** by Fallon (Relating to the use of a mobile phone by a person occupying a voting station.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Election Code relating to the use of a mobile phone by a person occupying a voting station.

The Secretary of State assumes any additional work associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

The bill would take effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, or on September 1, 2017.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
