IN RE: HB812 by Wu (Relating to standing in a roadway; amending provisions subject to a criminal penalty.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code prohibiting a person from standing in a roadway that impedes vehicular traffic or presents a danger to the person or another person.

The bill would repeal Sections 552.006(b), 552.07(b)-(c) and 522.0071 of the Transportation Code.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.
