IN RE: HB840 by Ortega (Relating to authorization for a county or municipality to establish a local minimum wage.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Labor Code relating to the establishment of a minimum wage. The bill would allow a municipality or county to establish a minimum wage that is higher than the state adopted minimum wage.

The bill would go into effect September 1, 2017.
