**IN RE: HB864** by Blanco (Relating to designation of an employee within certain state agencies as a veterans liaison.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend Chapter 657, Government Code to require certain state agencies to designate a full-time employee of the agency to serve as a veteran's liaison.
