**IN RE:** **HB1104** by Hernandez (Relating to sexual assault and domestic violence awareness continuing education for cosmetology license holders.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to sexual assault and domestic violence awareness training and reporting by cosmetology license holders.

The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation indicates it could absorb the costs associated with the bill within its current resources.
