IN RE: HB1120 by Springer (Relating to the authority of a political subdivision to issue a building construction permit or final certificate of occupancy for a building or facility required to meet certain accessibility standards; requiring a related study.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

## No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code relating to the authority of a political subdivision to issue a building construction permit or final certificate of occupancy for a building or facility required to meet certain accessibility standards; requiring a related study. The bill would require the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) to conduct a study regarding the effects of the changes in law made by the bill. TDLR would be required to submit a report on the completed study no later than November 1, 2018.

TDLR indicates it could absorb the costs associated with the bill within its current resources.

## **Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Municipal League, the fiscal implication to units of local government is not anticipated to be significant.
