IN RE: HB1238 by VanDeaver (Relating to investment training for commissioners of public housing authorities.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to modify the required hours of an investment training for certain housing authority financial officers.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.
