**IN RE: HB1361** by White (Relating to the dismissal of certain suits affecting the parent-child relationship in which the court has rendered a temporary order.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Family Code to eliminate jurisdiction over certain suits affecting the parent-child relationship filed by a person who is not a parent of the child. The Office of Court Administration has indicated it could implement the provisions of the bill with existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
