IN RE: HB1368 by Israel (Relating to the prima facie speed limit in an urban district.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code allowing a prima facie speed limit for a residential street to be set at 25 miles per hour, instead of the current 30 miles per hour.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.
