**IN RE: HB1368** by Israel (Relating to the prima facie speed limit in an urban district.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code allowing a prima facie speed limit for a residential street to be set at 25 miles per hour, instead of the current 30 miles per hour.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
