**IN RE: HB1406** by Blanco (Relating to the authority of the asset management division of the General Land Office to sell real property to a federally recognized Indian tribe.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Natural Resources Code to allow the General Land Office (GLO) to sell land to a federally recognized Indian tribe. GLO has indicated it could implement the provisions of the bill with existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
