**IN RE:** **HB1420** by Martinez, "Mando" (Relating to the imposition of a late payment penalty against Medicaid managed care organizations that fail to timely pay certain physician and provider claims.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would impose a late payment penalty on managed care organizations that fail to pay certain physician and provider claims in a timely manner.

Based on the analysis provided by the Health and Human Services Commission, the provisions of the bill can be implemented within existing resources.
