IN RE: **HB1450** by González, Mary (Relating to state collaboration with federally recognized Indian tribes.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code relating to state collaboration with federally recognized Indian tribes. The bill would add Chapter 471 to require the Governor, or his or her designee, to meet once a year with tribes. The Office of the Governor and the Secretary of State indicate that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within each agency's existing resources. The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving two-thirds majority vote in each house. Otherwise the bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
