IN RE: HB1910 by Sanford (Relating to the form of ballot propositions in an election seeking authorization for the issuance of school district bonds supported by property taxes.), **As Introduced**

The bill's provisions limit the governing board or commissioners court to one project in any proposition submitted to authorize the issuance of bonds.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.
