**IN RE:** **HB1956** by Springer (Relating to the operation of certain off-highway vehicles.), As Engrossed

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code relating to the designation and operation of utility and off-highway vehicles.

The bill would repeal Sections 551.401(2), 663.001(1), and 663.003 of the Transportation Code.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.
