IN RE: HB2100 by Kuempel (Relating to authority of certain general-law municipalities to annex an area without consent.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code relating to annexation of an area without consent. The bill would only apply to a municipality with a population of 550 to 750 and is located in a county that is adjacent to a county with a population of 1.5 million or more and contains a municipality in which at least 75 percent of the county's population resides.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

Local Government Impact

According to Texas Municipal League (TML), the fiscal impact of the bill on local government cannot be determined.
