IN RE: HB2187 by Lucio III (Relating to the revocation or amendment of a certificate of public convenience and necessity for water utilities in a service area.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Water Code and the Government Code relating to the revocation or amendment of a certificate of public convenience and necessity for water utilities in a service area. Based on the analysis of the Public Utility Commission (PUC), duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
