IN RE: HB2213 by Kacal (Relating to the dissolution of the Falls County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would dissolve the Falls County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 and transfer the assets to the City of Marlin. The dissolution would take effect on the effective date of the bill.

The bill would take effect immediately if it receives a two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2017.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
