**IN RE: HB2477** by Davis, Sarah (Relating to the authority of certain municipal employees to request the removal and storage of certain illegally parked or operated vehicles.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code allowing a municipality to designate an employee to request the removal and storage of a vehicle that is illegally operated for hire or parked illegally in an area designated as two-away zone where on-street parking is regulated by an ordinance.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Municipal League (TML), no fiscal impact is anticipated for local government.
