**IN RE: HB2815** by Oliverson (Relating to early in-person voting by voters who reside at a residential care facility.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Election Code and Health and Safety Code allowing certain persons at a residential care facility to request a mail in ballot and allow early voting at residential care facilities.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

**Local Government Impact**

According to Williamson County and the Texas Association of Counties, the potential local government cost to implement the provisions of the bill would be significant but cannot be estimated currently.
