IN RE: HB2993 by Phillips (Relating to the public transportation advisory committee.), As
Engrossed

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 455 of the Transportation Code to require the Texas Transportation Commission, instead of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the House in current law, to appoint members to the Public Transportation Advisory Committee.

The Texas Department of Transportation indicates that any costs or duties associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
