IN RE: HB3066 by Guillen (Relating to certain benefits and protections for service members of the Texas military forces ordered to state active duty or to state training and other duty.),
Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Government Code relating to benefits for members of the state military forces called to active state duty.

The agency estimates there would be a minimal cost associated with implementing the provisions of the bill.
