**IN RE: HB3101** by Kuempel (Relating to authorizing the sale of alcoholic beverages on certain passenger buses; authorizing a fee.), **As Introduced** 

There would be an indeterminate amount of revenue generated from the new fee authorized by the bill.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code to create a passenger bus beverage permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages on certain passenger bus vehicles. The bill would require a passenger bus beverage permit be issued only to a passenger bus that also transports an attendant who is not the operator of the bus who has also attended a Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission approved seller training program. The annual fee for a passenger bus beverage permit would be \$500.

The Comptroller of Public Accounts reports that while the new permit could increase fee revenue to the state, the number of corporations that would seek and be approved for a permit is unknown and therefore the fee collection amounts cannot be determined.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

## **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
