IN RE: HB3250 by Leach (Relating to public work contracts of governmental entities.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Subchapter B of Chapter 2269 of the Government Code, regarding contracting and delivery procedures for construction projects.

The bill would authorize a governmental entity to implement a prequalification process to eliminate unqualified offerors from consideration for a public work project and specify requirements and authorizations with regards to the process.

The bill would take effect on September 1, 2017.

The Texas Facilities Commission, Texas Military Department, Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Department of Transportation, Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Texas Education Agency, Texas A&M University System, University of Texas System, Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, Texas Historical Commission and State Preservation Board indicate that the bill would have no fiscal impact on the respective agency or institution.

The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department indicates that it could absorb the costs associated with the bill within its current resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
