IN RE: HB3328 by Rodriguez, Eddie (Relating to the disclosure of public information relating to expenditures for voter identification education.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Election Code relating to the disclosure of public information relating to expenditures for voter identification education.

The Secretary of State assumes any additional work associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

The bill would take effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house or on September 1, 2017.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
