**IN RE:** **HB3329** by Paddie (Relating to regulation of electricians by local governments.),  
**Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Occupations Code by prohibiting a municipality or region from collecting a permit, registration, administrative, or any other fee from a licensed electrician. The bill would allow a municipality or region to collect a building permit fee.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Municipal League, the fiscal impact to municipalities is not anticipated to be significant.
