**IN RE: HB3464** by Schofield (Relating to early in-person voting by voters who reside at a residential care facility.), **As Introduced** 

#### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Election Code and Health and Safety Code allowing certain persons at a residential care facility to vote by mail and allow early voting at residential care facilities.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

### **Local Government Impact**

According to Williamson County and the Texas Association of Counties, the potential local government cost to implement the provisions of the bill would be significant but cannot currently be estimated.
