**IN RE: HB3506** by Cyrier (Relating to the authority of a political subdivision to adopt or enforce a requirement that a builder or contractor obtain a license or other similar certification from the political subdivision.), **Committee Report 1st House**, **Substituted** 

#### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code prohibiting a local governmental entity from requiring a builder or contractor to obtain a local license for construction or remodel of a commercial structure.

The bill would take effect immediately if the bill receives a two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

The Texas Department of Insurance would be able to implement the bill with existing agency resources.

### **Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Municipal League, no significant fiscal impact is anticipated.
