IN RE: HB3648 by Goldman (Relating to identification for voting.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Election Code to authorize either the book form or card form of United States passport identification for use as voter identification. It is assumed any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within existing resources.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
