IN RE: HB3726 by Dale (relating to certain examination and continuing education requirements for applicants for and holders of liquefied petroleum gas licenses.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Natural Resources Code to allow the Railroad Commission (RRC) to require that an applicant for a liquefied petroleum gas license, in addition to other requirements, complete a technical examination or attend continuing education courses. The bill would remove RRC's ability to require periodic reexaminations. Based on the analysis of the Railroad Commission, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished with existing resources.

### Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
