IN RE: HB3749 by Phelan (relating to the applicability of the law regarding the authority to construct or maintain a facility or structure on state land.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Natural Resources Code to provide a definition for "structure or facility" on state-owned land for Chapter 51, Subchapter G, Easements. Based on the analysis of the General Land Office, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished using existing resources.
