**IN RE:** **HB3767** by Allen (Relating to annual reporting regarding the establishment of certain school district planning and decision-making committees.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill requires each board of trustees to annually certify to TEA that the board has established district- and campus-level improvement committees.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2017, or immediately if passed with the necessary voting margins, and would apply beginning with school year 2017-18.

**Local Government Impact**

School boards are already required to annually update and/or create district- and campus-level improvement committees. Districts would incur minimal costs associated the submission of information certifying the annual establishment of the committees to TEA.
