IN RE: HB4007 by Kuempel (Relating to the licensing and regulation of health-related occupations transferred to the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation.), As **Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the licensing and regulation of healthrelated occupations transferred to the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR).
