IN RE: HB4013 by Frullo (Relating to the release of a child taken into possession by a law enforcement or juvenile probation officer.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure relating to the release of a child taken into possession by a law enforcement or juvenile probation officer.

It is assumed that costs associated with the implementation of the bill could be absorbed within existing agency resources.
