IN RE: **SB80** by Nelson (Relating to certain required reports prepared by state agencies and other governmental entities.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill amends various statutes including the Education, Government, and Health and Safety Codes to modify or eliminate certain required reports and other documents prepared by state agencies. The bill would have a positive but not significant fiscal impact to the state.
